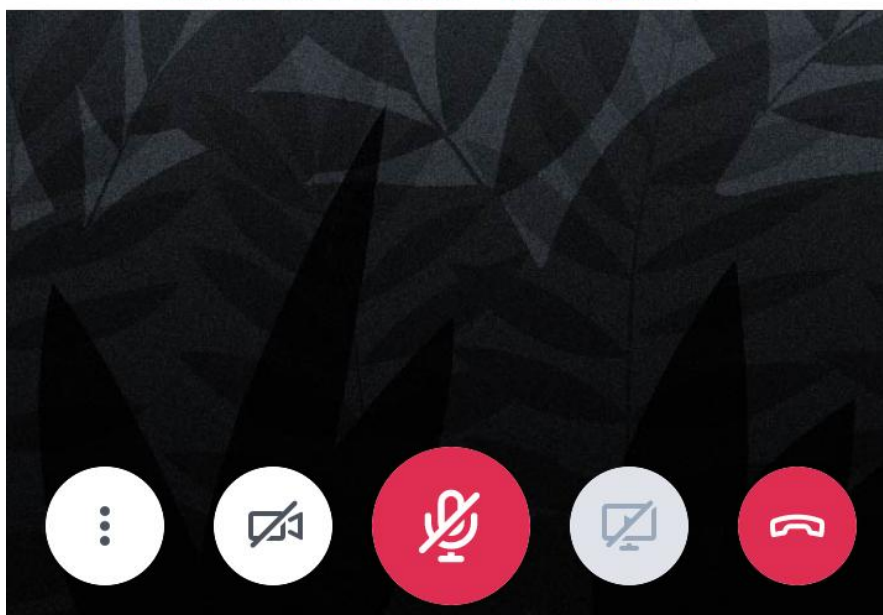

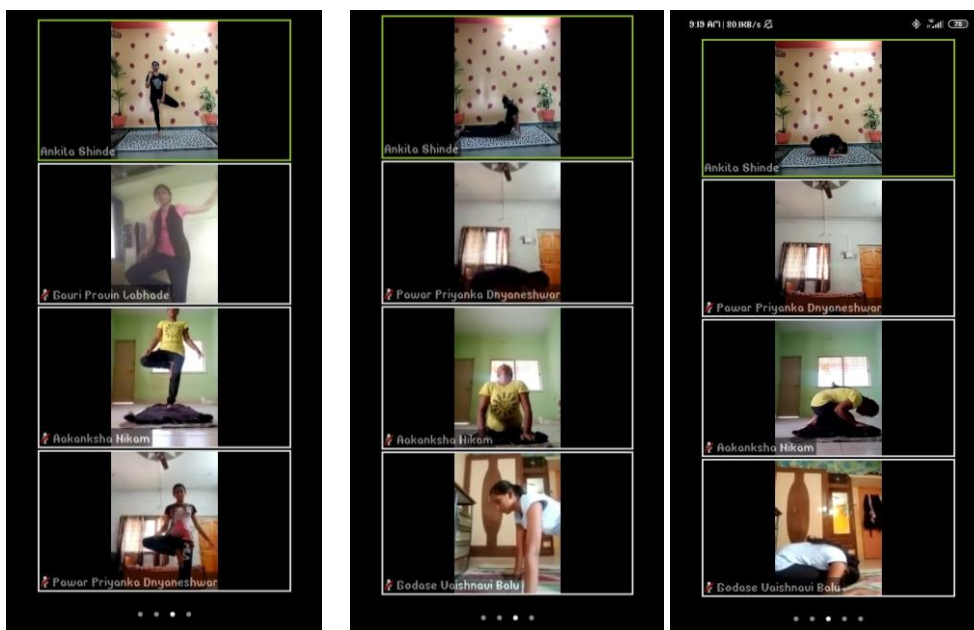


- **International Yoga Day Celebration**

• **Covid-19 Awareness Program**

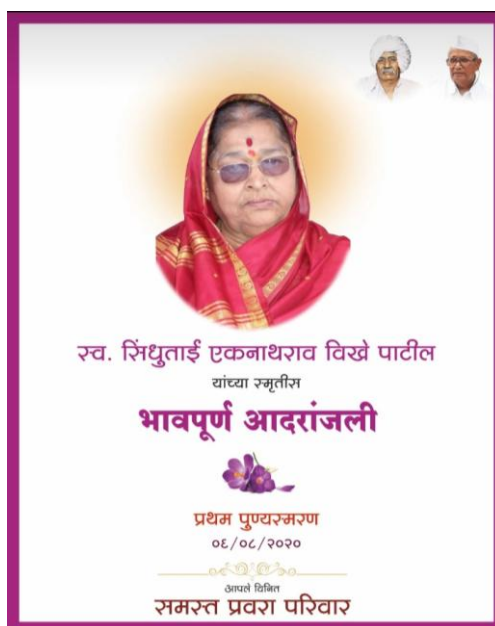

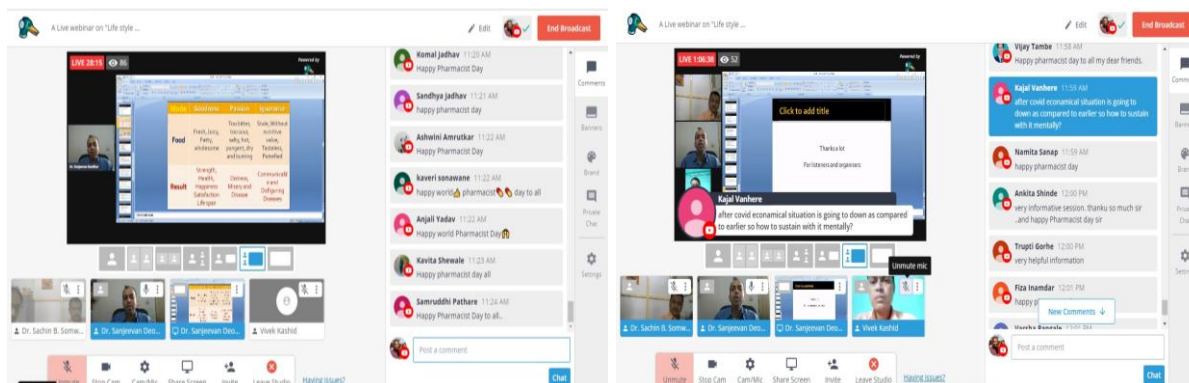
• World Pharmacist Day Celebration

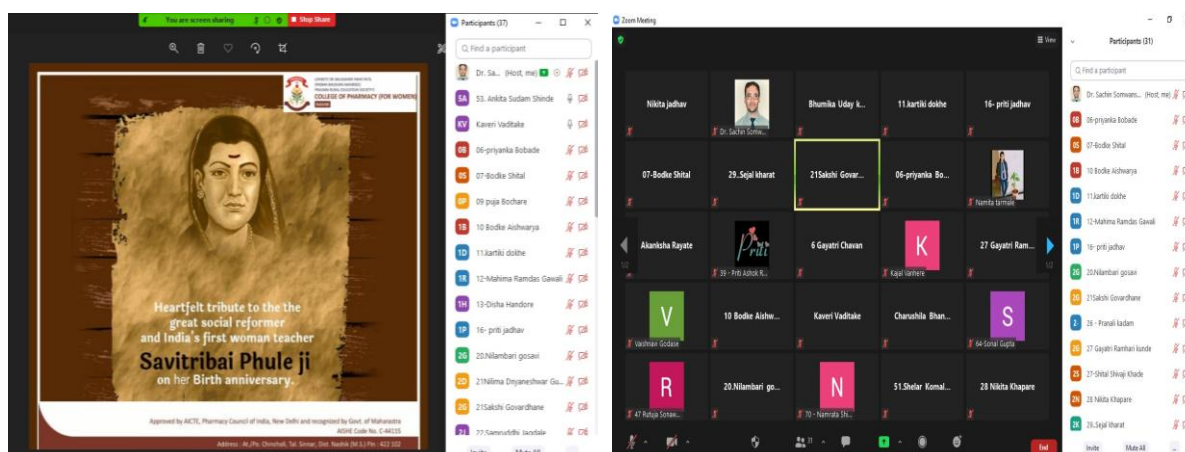


• Tribute paid to Krantijyoti Savitribai Phule

• **"Jal Shakti Abhiyaan-2020-21" Under the Theme "Catch the rain"**

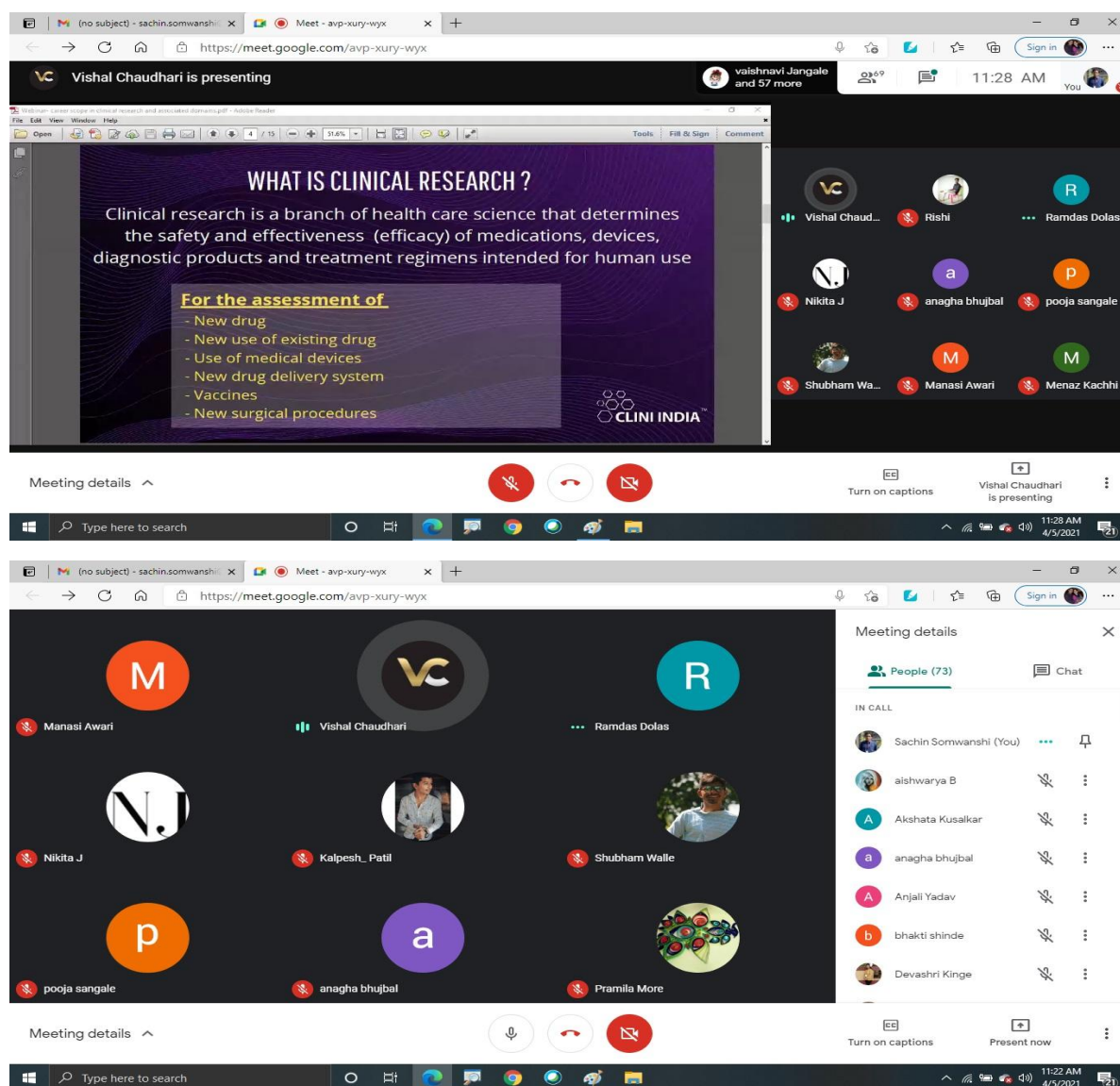
