

• Teachers Day celebration



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
• Conducted Virtual "हितगुज: शिक्षक-पालक मेळावा"





• National level Webinar on "Demonstration of Minitab and Design Expert software for optimization using case study"


• NSS Day Celebration







• World Pharmacist Day Celebration


Also, Tree was planted on the occasion of World Pharmacist Day 2020 in the college premises.

• A webinar on "Career Trends in Clinical Research and Clinical Data Analytics"








Online workshop on Employable Skill Enhancement
