


• National Level Online Quiz on Environment Awareness under theme "Ecosystem Restoration Campaign"






• International Yoga Day Celebration


• Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme


• Celebration of National Librarian Day

Webinar on the occasion 121th birth anniversary Padmashri Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil


