**Pharmacy Students are able to:**

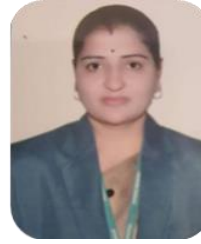

### • Ganesh Murti and Nirmalya Sankalan 2021

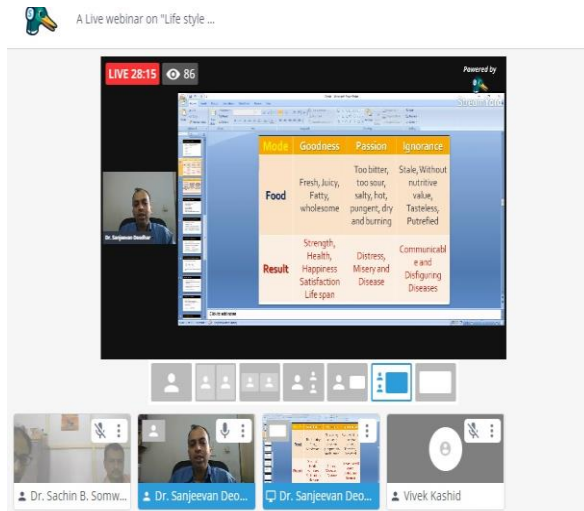

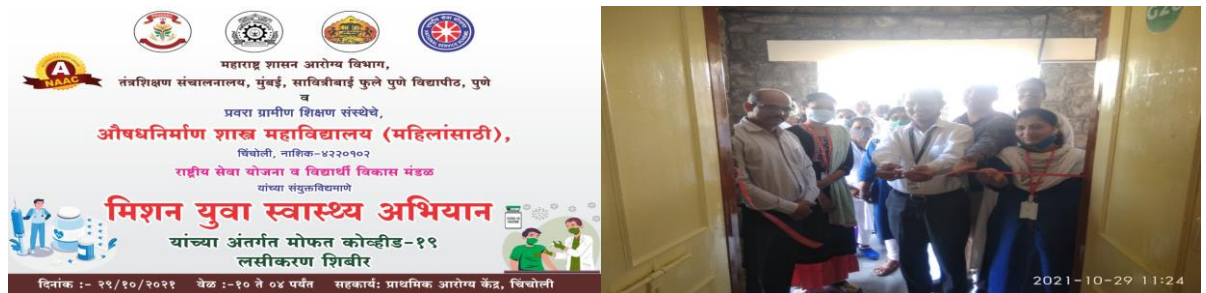
• **Anti-Tobacco Workshop 2021**

• **National unity day 2021**

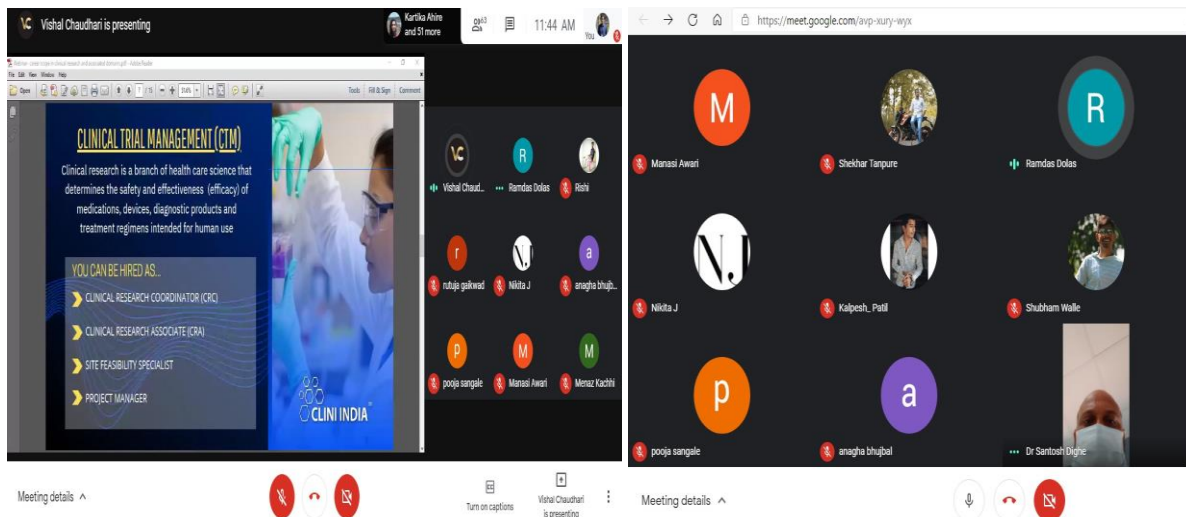
