**Aims:**

- To shift values, beliefs, attitudes, behaviors and practices (among individuals, and within communities and institutions) to recognize gender inequality as unacceptable and contrary to religious teaching and practice.
- To help ensure that community level faith responses to gender injustice are more effective and sustainable.
- To help ensure that legal systems (including religious and customary laws) recognize, prevent and adequately respond to gender injustice.
- To help ensure that gender justice is an explicit aim both of religious institutions and governments – with effective policies, programmes and resources in place to achieve it.
- To work to ensure that faith actors are no longer seen as a barrier to gender justice, but are recognized and supported to play a distinctive role in securing gender justice and the rights of both women and men, boys and girls.

**Objectives:**

- To promote understanding of the common grounds and shared goals between many women's movements and other social justice movements.
- To consider the strategic value for movements of combining forces.
- To promote honest discussion of the obstacles to integrating and highlighting gender equality in the work of other social justice movements, and to working together in a more engaged, constructive way.
- To provide spaces and opportunities for movements and activists to come together to generate and share knowledge on effective approaches, strategies and conceptual frameworks.
- Equal career opportunities for women and men
- Fair distribution of unpaid and paid work among women and men, wages and salaries that women and men can live on independently
- Equality of women and men with regard to political representation and participation
- Enhancement of gender roles and standards for women and men, elimination of restricting standards
- Same personal freedoms for women and men, protection against all forms of aggression
